



INFORMATION FOR PROSPECTIVE PARENTS

Welcome to KINDERWORLD Bournemouth Day Nursery.

We are a family-run, Ofsted-registered nursery located at 6 Knyveton Road, Bournemouth, offering high-quality childcare and education to children aged 4 months to 5 years. The nursery operates Monday to Friday, from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., throughout the year, excluding UK public holidays and a one-week closure at Christmas.

Full day and half day places are available for all children aged 4 months–4 years 11 months.

As a parent you will want to know about the type of care which your child will receive while at Kinderworld Day Nursery. We hope that the following information will be helpful.

General Philosophy

At Kinderworld, we believe in nurturing each child's unique potential through a blend of free play and structured learning activities. Our approach fosters curiosity, creativity, and social awareness, ensuring that children develop a positive self-image and a love for learning. We prioritise emotional well-being, providing a happy, loving atmosphere where children feel safe and valued, with plenty of cuddles, supporting each child to develop his/her true potential.

Individualised Care Through the Key Person Approach

At Kinderworld Bournemouth Day Nursery, we recognise the importance of personalised care in fostering each child's development. To achieve this, our staff are assigned to small groups, ensuring that every child has one or two dedicated key persons. These key persons build strong, trusting relationships with the children and their families, providing consistent support and comfort. This approach helps children feel secure and valued, enabling them to thrive in a nurturing environment.

Staff

At Kinderworld, your child will be cared for by a team of experienced and qualified practitioners, working within the statutory ratios set out in the Children Act. These ratios ensure the safety and wellbeing of all children and are as follows:

- Under 2 years old: A maximum of 3 babies to 1 practitioner
- Aged 2–3 years: A maximum of 5 children to 1 practitioner
- Aged 3–5 years: A maximum of 8 children to 1 practitioner

Our team is selected not only for their professional qualifications, but also for their warm, nurturing approach to supporting young children.

Staff Professional Qualifications and Ongoing Development

To ensure we consistently deliver the highest standard of childcare, we are committed to employing professional staff who are either fully qualified as Nursery Practitioners or are actively working towards a recognised childcare qualification.

Our team members are skilled in supporting the individual needs of each child, helping them grow with confidence and curiosity. We also prioritise continuous professional development, providing regular training opportunities to keep our staff up-to-date with the latest developments, best practices, and innovations in early years education.

Hygge in the Early Years Accredited and Nature inspired

At Kinderworld, we are proud to be a '*Hygge in the Early Years Accredited Nursery*'. This approach focuses on creating a calm, cosy, and nurturing environment where children feel safe, valued, and inspired to explore. As part of this ethos, we follow the '*Wanderlust Nature Programme*'—a carefully designed, year-round curriculum that encourages children to develop a deeper connection with the natural world and sustainability. Through seasonal outdoor activities, nature walks, sensory play, and mindful exploration, we help babies and young children foster a lifelong love for the outdoors while supporting their emotional wellbeing, creativity, and curiosity.

The Premises

As a Hygge in the Early Years accredited nursery, we offer a warm, homely, and nurturing environment. Our nursery occupies both the ground and first floors of a spacious, purpose-renovated building situated in attractive surroundings. Conveniently located close to Christchurch Road, the Bournemouth Travel Interchange, Asda, the Poole to Ringwood dual carriageway, and central Bournemouth, Kinderworld provides a calm and welcoming setting for all children in our care.

Indoor Facilities:

Ground Floor

The ground floor hosts a cosy yet spacious room for 2–3-year-olds, complete with a quiet den area for rest and relaxation. A larger shared playroom caters to 2–4-year-olds, featuring an open-plan layout ideal for nursery education and group activities. Children can explore themed zones, including:

- Role play
- Comfy book corner
- Mark-making area
- Science and investigation
- Emotions and wellbeing
- Problem-solving, reasoning and numeracy
- Small world and construction
- Puzzle and fine motor activities
- A small fish tank for observation

An adjoining craft/dining room supports messy play and mealtimes, with free-flow access between both rooms. Activities such as painting, dough, water, cooking, and crafts are regularly offered here. Meals, including breakfast, snacks, lunch, and tea, are prepared in our fully equipped kitchen by our in-house cook, who caters for dietary needs.

Other key ground floor features include:

- A spacious cloakroom by the entrance for coats and shoes
- A garden/boot room equipped with wellies and waterproofs (provided by parents/carers)
- An accessible toilet next to the garden room for outdoor use

First Floor

The first floor is designed for our youngest children:

- A dedicated room for 0–1-year-olds with changing facilities, a milk kitchen, free-choice boxes, and access to a monitored cot room
- Two spacious play and rest areas for 1–2-year-olds with zones for books, role play, physical activity, and sensory treasure baskets
- A nappy changing area and potty training facilities
- Regular access to the garden

There is also a staff room where practitioners take breaks, complete administrative work, and prepare resources.

Outdoor Learning Environment

Our large outdoor garden is a rich, stimulating environment offering:

- Grassy areas for free play
- Vegetable and fruit growing areas
- A woodchip section with climbing equipment and swings
- A hard-surface area for bikes, scooters, and ball games
- A shaded seating area with a storytelling chair
- A wooden play cabin for role play
- A mud kitchen and water tray
- A covered outdoor pavilion
- Spaces to explore wildlife, including a mini-beast area, bird feeders, and a pet's corner

Children access the garden year-round, in all weathers, supported by appropriate clothing and a variety of seasonal resources and activities, such as water play and picnics in the summer.

Other Accreditations

Bournemouth Quality Standards Accreditation

Kinderworld is proud to have achieved the Bournemouth Quality Standards Accreditation. This quality mark promotes a culture of continuous improvement and supports high-quality provision for all early years children.

We have successfully completed and been accredited in all eight modules:

3. Being and Becoming
4. Contributing and Participating
5. Being Active and Expressing
6. Thinking, Imagining, and Understanding

Healthy Early Years (HEY) Project

We also took part in the Bournemouth Healthy Early Years (HEY) project and are delighted to have earned both BRONZE and SILVER HEY accredited status. Our HEY plaques are on display in our entrance to reflect our ongoing commitment to promoting children's health and wellbeing.



The Importance of the Early Years

The early years of a child's life are crucial in laying the foundation for future learning and development. At Kinderworld, we recognise the significance of these formative years and aim to provide enriching experiences that nurture the whole child.

There are four key needs of children during the pre-school years:

1. The need for love and security
2. The need for new and stimulating experiences
3. The need for praise and recognition
4. The need for a framework of responsible behaviour

We strive to meet these needs in our daily care, through loving interactions, thoughtful planning, and a safe, secure environment. Children's health, safety, and hygiene—especially in areas such as our kitchen and toilets—are a top priority.

Settling In and Starting at the Nursery

We understand how important it is for children to feel secure and confident when starting nursery. That's why we offer settling-in sessions prior to your child's start date and allocate a dedicated Key Person to each child. This practitioner forms a close, nurturing relationship with your child and supports their emotional wellbeing and development from day one.

The Key Person is also your main point of contact for sharing updates, discussing development, and collaborating on your child's learning journey.

As children settle in, they are gently introduced to new friendships, routines, and learning experiences, helping them grow in confidence, independence, and social understanding.

Nursery Education

Kinderworld provides Nursery Education within a Full Day Nursery setting, offering working parents the assurance that their child is receiving high-quality early learning alongside flexible childcare.

We are open year-round (except bank holidays and a week at Christmas), unlike traditional term-time Nursery Schools. This continuity supports consistent learning and prevents regression over long holiday periods. Our approach combines structured learning through play with plenty of breaks, free play, and a relaxed atmosphere that enhances children's ability to concentrate and enjoy learning.

We accept Nursery Education Funding on a stretched basis and are proud to be Ofsted registered, with an excellent inspection report.

Care, Learning, and Development

Kinderworld provides care and education in an environment which enables children to feel safe and supported and which extends their learning and development, and we keenly celebrate the skills and competence of all babies and young children.

Most children come to the Nursery with a wealth of experience to draw upon. They have learnt about people and their environment and have begun to develop many of the skills they need to operate in their world, but it is the task of the Nursery Practitioners to build on this experience to extend their learning.

We follow the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Development Matters, which sets the standards for the learning, development, and care of children from birth to five, including the *safeguarding and welfare requirements*. It sets the standards for keeping the children healthy and safe.

We also follow the Hygge in the Early Years approach and the Wanderlust Nature Programme. Our aim is to create an inclusive, welcoming, and stimulating environment where all children can be happy, flourish and learn.

At Kinderworld, we believe that learning through play is the most natural and effective way for young children to explore the world and develop new skills.

For 0–2-year-olds:

Our youngest children enjoy a nurturing and calm environment that supports their emotional and sensory development. Activities include indoor and outdoor physical play, sensory play, exploratory toys, stories and rhymes, creative activities and lots of cuddles and comfort.

For 2–5-year-olds:

A wide variety of play-based learning experiences are provided, including:

- Physical play (tricycles, balls, climbing frames)
- Fine motor skill activities (threading, puzzles, small world toys)
- Creative expression (paint, dressing up, music)
- Communication and storytelling in cosy book corners
- Problem-solving, counting, sorting and early maths
- Outdoor exploration and imaginative play in nature

We have a cot room for babies needing a sleep during the day. Older babies and toddlers requiring a midday rest can sleep on mats in a quiet area between 12:30 and 2:00 p.m.

Our curriculum underlines the importance of home and family working together with practitioners to lay the best possible foundations for life and learning. It is based on principles of inclusion which means that we oppose discrimination and prejudice and welcome all families and children.

Kinderworld focuses on the principles from the EYFS, these are grouped into four themes:

‘A Unique Child’,

Positive Relationships’

‘Enabling Environments’ (indoors and outdoors), and

‘Learning and Development’.

Our activities are informed by observations on the children and are planned with each child’s interests and abilities in mind. Nursery themes or topics also support development by introducing new concepts and knowledge to children.

We provide a well-planned and resourced curriculum to take their learning forward and we provide opportunities for all children to succeed in an atmosphere of care and of feeling valued.

To support children’s independence and individual learning we encourage children to choose which activities they would like to participate in throughout the day, this not only enables them to have more choice but also allows them to spend longer at activities if they so wish in order to complete something or feel satisfied.

Throughout the EYFS, stress is placed upon understanding each child and their family as unique, with different needs and concerns. Children's development is presented under seven interconnecting phases. This inter-connection is intended to emphasise the fact that there can be big differences between the development of children of similar ages.

The Prime areas are: Physical Development, Personal, Social and Emotional Development and Communication and Language.

The Specific areas are: Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding the world and Expressive Arts and Design

Monitoring Progress and Supporting Individual Needs

We closely monitor each child's progress through observations and regular assessments. This helps us to:

- Celebrate achievements
- Identify any areas of additional need
- Provide suitable challenges for more able children
- Collaborate with parents on each child's next steps

We conduct a **two-year progress check**, as required by the EYFS, in partnership with parents and health visitors. This early review helps ensure that support is in place if needed.

We also complete a **school transition form** for each child leaving for school.

Additional Support for a child:

We are committed to **inclusive practice**. If we feel a child requires additional support, and Local Authority funding is unavailable, we will work with parents/carers to determine the required level of support and any associated costs in addition to your Nursery Fees.

Working in Partnership with Parents

At Kinderworld, we value strong partnerships with parents. We believe that parents are their child's first and most enduring educators. A two-way flow of information between home and nursery enriches a child's learning and helps us meet their unique needs.

We support this partnership by:

- Assigning a Key Person to each child
- Sharing daily verbal updates and development milestones
- Welcoming parent contributions to learning, such as bringing in items for interest tables or sharing family experiences
- Regular communication via email, phone, or in person
- Encouraging feedback and suggestions

When a child joins the nursery, we ask parents to complete a detailed questionnaire and provide previous development records if available from a previous childcare setting. This helps us to create a personalised learning journey from the very beginning.

The following **Enhanced Parent Partnership** Service is also available to Fee Paying children (Private and Wrap Around hours and those opting in to the enhanced service through payment in addition to free hours)

- Access to the 'Evidence Me' App to share photos, observations, and achievements
- Regular written Development Reviews

These additional services help create a picture of your child, the activities they are taking part in, social interactions and the progress they are making.

General Information

Registration and Settling-In

When you first contact Kinderworld Day Nursery, we will send you a welcome email including:

- A virtual tour video of the nursery
- Registration forms and policies for you to read and keep

Before booking a place, your child is invited to view the nursery with a parent or carer, this is an opportunity for you to meet the team and ask any questions you may have.

Once you confirm your child's place, you'll receive a **welcome pack** containing important documents to be completed and returned. We will also need to see your child's **original birth certificate or passport** at the time of registration.

Your child will then be invited to attend a few short settling in sessions prior to their first day at nursery. This helps both you and your child get to know our team, environment, and routines at a comfortable pace.

Session Times and Attendance

Our nursery is open **Monday to Friday, from 7:30am to 6:00pm**, for 50-51 weeks of the year. Please see fees for actual session times on offer.

We close for approximately one week at Christmas and on all public holidays—**no fees are charged for these closures**.

The **minimum weekly attendance** is **2 days per week, per child**.

Children should arrive promptly by:

- **9am** for full-day sessions

This ensures minimal disruption to group activities and enables staff to properly welcome and settle each child.

If your child receives **Early Years Funding** (either Universal OR Working Families) then regular attendance is essential. Repeated absence may lead to the **withdrawal of funding**, in which case full nursery fees would become payable.

Fees and Meals

Our current fee structure is outlined in the **attached daily fee schedule**.

We offer nutritious meals prepared on-site by our dedicated cook, with attention to dietary needs and allergies. Meals are optional and available to purchase for children who are on solid foods.

Available meals include:

- **Breakfast**
- **Hot cooked lunch**
- **Cold afternoon tea**

Please refer to the attached meal fees for pricing details.

Absences and Holidays

Nursery fees and charges for additional or enhanced services are payable **throughout the year**, including during your child's absence due to illness or holiday.

To avoid being charged for nursery meals during holidays, **at least one month's written notice** must be given. If this notice is not provided, meal charges will still apply.

Fees and charges for additional or enhanced services remain payable for:

- Holidays
- Appointments
- Illness
- Self-isolation (e.g., 24 hours after a temperature or 48 hours after sickness)
- Unplanned closures due to circumstances beyond our control (e.g., severe weather, utility failure)













Extra Enrichment

At Kinderworld Day Nursery, we believe in offering outstanding value through an enriching and well-rounded experience.

Extra's included in Private Daily Fees, Wrap Around Fees and Parental Contributions for additional / Enhanced Services

Our daily private fees and wrap around fees are inclusive of all hours between 7.30am and 18.00pm as well as a wide range of extras and enhanced services (The Enhanced Education and Care Package- see below) designed to further improve your child's time with us.

The Enhanced Education & Care Package includes:

-  Baking activities
-  Language enrichment through French or Spanish lessons
-  Yoga and mindfulness sessions to support emotional wellbeing
-  Walks/ Outings in the local area (staff & weather permitting)
-  Enhanced Parent Partnership Service, including regular parent meetings and written progress reports/reviews
-  Healthy snacks
-  Occasional treats/gifts
-  Full Access to the *Evidence Me* online app, including regular photos, observations, and achievement updates
-  Occasional external educational visitors (e.g., Teacher Creatures and themed activities) *
-  Special guest visits
-  Seasonal parties / entertainers *
-  Consumables such as bedding, bibs, aprons, nappy sacks, cooking ingredients, seasonal craft materials, keepsakes, babies daily diary, weekly storage for personal items such as nappies, etc.

As part of the Enhanced Education & Care Package you also have **guaranteed permanent days** for your child until the end of August following their 4th birthday (prior to starting school).

As part of this **enhanced service package**, you may also **book and purchase Privately Paid Additional Days or Wrap-Around Hours**.

These enhancements contribute to providing a rich, balanced, and joyful early years experience—supporting each child's development in fun, meaningful, and memorable ways. They also help create a holistic picture of each child's learning journey, including their activities, social interactions, and individual progress.

These Extras are not included for free with 'funded only' places (where you choose to opt out of the enhanced services), however some items marked with a * may be available for you to purchase at an additional cost and will be discussed at the time.


Free / Funded hours

A **Parental Contribution of £2.00 per funded hour** (for babies 2 years and under) **OR £3.00 per funded hour** (for children age 3 years and older) is payable for the **Enhanced Education & Care Package** as detailed above. This is payable for each funded/free hour your child attends, when additional hours are not purchased (not applicable to private or wrap around fees).

If you are **unable** or **unwilling** to pay the parental contribution for the enhanced services (The Enhanced Education & Care Package) and only require our **basic service** (funded hours only, without any additional or enhanced provisions), a meeting with the nursery owner must be arranged before a place can be agreed. To register all Parents are required to complete and sign the *OPT IN/OPT-OUT form and submit it with the Registration form; the completed Policy agreement form and completed funding forms (if applicable)*.

- All Parents are required to bring named: suncream, sun hat, spare clothes, waterproof clothing, wellie boots, winter hat & gloves, fleece/jumper and a water bottle for their child in a small fabric tote bag.
- If your child requires nappies, cotton-wool/wipes, dummy, alternative to dairy milk, formula milk & baby bottles, teething medication, etc. parents are required to bring this.
- Nursery meals are optional and chargeable at an additional cost – see above, alternatively parents may bring cold food to be stored in our fridge.
- Kinderworld is unable to re-heat food from home for children age 2 years or older and is unable to store warm food for any child. If you require your child to have a hot meal they are charged at the rate above.

Kinderworld accepts all Nursery Funding; However the number of funded hours for 9mth olds and 4 year olds varies, dependant on when your child was born and the term, so 4 year olds may receive less funded hours in total once they turn 4. All 3 & 4 year olds can claim up to 15 hours Universal Funding on a stretched basis (up to 11 hours per week) over the 50-51 weeks we are open in the year.

- Parent(s) will need to read and sign our Parental Contract, regarding the Funding and complete an Early Education Funding Parent Declaration Form.
- At Kinderworld the 15 hours funding is claimed on a stretched basis over the whole year, as we are open for 50-51 weeks of the year. The maximum funding per week is 11 hours.
- Kinderworld requires a minimum attendance of 2 full days for 9 month olds, 1 year olds and 2 year olds claiming working families funding. Or a minimum of 2 half day sessions for 3 & 4 year olds claiming 'working families' or 'universal' funding. Or a minimum of 1 full day for children claiming the disadvantaged 2 year olds funding.

Working families can apply for the 30 hours funding on a stretched basis (up to 22 hours per week) over the 50-51 weeks we are open in the year. (30hrs = 15 hrs of Universal entitlement & up to 15 hrs of working families entitlement)

- To receive this Funding, parents will need to apply via www.childcarechoices.gov.uk.
- If the parent is eligible they will be issued with their own 11 digit Eligibility Code.
